hours 1,5 Time allowed :

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- 1- An 18- year-old G2 P1 at 35 weeks gestation has a history of Graves disease and is under treatment with oral propylthiouracil ( PTU ). She states that over the last day, she has been feeling as though her " heart is pounding" , she also complains of nervousness, sweating, and diarrhea.  
On examination, her blood pressure is 150/110 mm Hg, heart rate 140 beats per minute, respiratory rate 25 breaths per minute, and temperature 38.2 C. The patient appears anxious, disoriented, and somewhat confused. The thyroid gland is mildly tender and enlarged. The cardiac examination reveals tachycardia with III/VI systolic murmur. The fetal heart rate tracing shows a baseline in the 160 bpm range without decelerations. Deep tendon reflexes are 4 + with clonus. Her leukocyte count is 20,000/mm<sup>3</sup>.
- 2- A 17-year-old nulliparous female complains that she not yet started menstruation . She had a missing right kidney on an abdominal x-ray film, her two sisters achieved menarche by 13 years of age. On examination, she is 145 cm in tall and weigh 60. Kg, Her blood pressure is 110 / 60 mmHg, her thyroid gland is normal on palpation. She has tanner stage IV breast development. As well as a normal axillary, pubic hair and female external genitalia.
